



Careers Calendar for Year 13 Considering Higher Education?

September

- 1 September UCAS applications open
- Apply for sponsorship – See Unifaqs and/or degree apprenticeships – see Jobfaqs, both are on ckcareersonline
- Start to apply for GAP year projects
- Check deadlines for Art Foundation courses

October

- 2 October closing date for on time CUKAS (music conservatoires) applications. Auditions start.
- 15 October - course application deadline for Oxford, Cambridge, and medicine, dentistry and veterinary science courses. Apply for entrance test for some of these courses.
- Interviews may start.

November-December

- Expect responses from institutions, including invitations to visit.
- Check deadlines for accepting/rejecting offers. If you miss them, you lose your place.
- Learn to cook!

January

- 15 January - UCAS deadline for 'on time' applications (including some art and design courses).
- CUKAS decision deadlines due, so check your offers.

February

- 25 February - if you have no offers, UCAS Extra starts - check out courses with vacancies.
- Apply online for finance from Student Finance England.

March

- 24 March - deadline for remaining art and design courses.
- Think about applying for university accommodation.

April

- Art and design course interviews start.

May

- 2 May - if you got all your offers by 31 March, you must reply to offers by this date.
- 3 May - institutions must make their offers by this date for those applications made by 15 January
- 31 May - want to receive your loan on time? Student Finance application deadline.

June

- 7 June - if you got all your offers by 3 May, you must reply to offers by this date.
- 21 June - if you got all your offers by 7 June, you must reply to offers by this date.
- 30 June UCAS applications close, **from now on applications automatically go into Clearing.**

July

- 4 July – last date to apply via UCAS Extra
- 5 July – clearing opens

August

- Results out - make sure you are at home!
- Reply to all offers
- Clearing starts, get help from your tutor and careers adviser
- Consider Adjustment, if your results are better than expected and you want to check out other course possibilities.
- Check your accommodation offers or apply if you haven't yet done so. Learn budgeting skills.



September-October

- Clearing continues.
- Courses start – good luck and enjoy!
