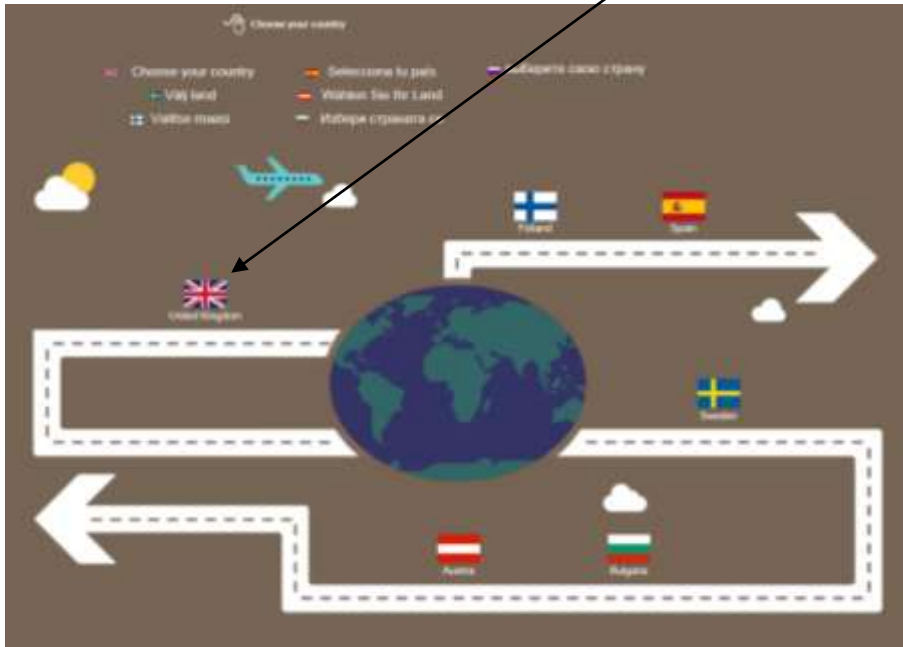


www.info4migrants.com is a new online resource for migrants and advisers working with migrants, produced by Careers Europe (Aspire-igen).

It provides information for individuals and advisers on a range of topics such as education, status and rights and employment - for six different countries including the UK. So, on the home page, you select UK under 'Choose your Country'...



You can **then** choose to have the information about these countries in **English, Arabic, French, Polish, Romanian and Urdu**.

It isn't immediately obvious how you switch languages. Once you've clicked on the appropriate flag for the country you want information about (presumably UK in our case), you can select the language as indicated in the arrow here:

.....and then changed the language to Arabic the 'I am an adviser/I need advice' screen would look like this



(Back in English) if you select "I'm an adviser" you can choose from:
NB these options are only available in the English versions



Back on the UK page, if you select “I need advice” you get these options:



Again, if you change the language to Arabic, you get fewer options and the screen looks like this
