**Vicky:** "The course here is for erm teenage parents, or young people that are pregnant. It's run by Barnados it's called Parents with Prospects. It's a level 1 certificate in caring for children."

**Danny:** "Er well we come in and we just talk about like child development, and how healthy we can make us kids and stuff like that."
